Baptism take place in the context of our 10 a.m. Sung Eucharist on Sundays. We try to have them on major feast days (Easter, Pentecost, All Saints', etc.) but there is considerable flexibility, as we appreciate that gathering a family and friends for a baptism can take some arranging!

It is necessary that godparents be baptised and preferable that they be confirmed. If the child being baptised is a boy, conventionally there are two godfathers and one godmother. If the child being baptised is a girl, conventionally there are two godmothers and one godfather. However, it is a matter of parental preference and you may want to have more than three godparents. Please discuss this with me before the baptism.

If parents have not been confirmed, they may like to take the baptism of their child as an opportunity to discuss the possibility of being confirmed. We have confirmation courses every year.

There is no fee for a baptism.
