

# A CHURCH IN SOUTHGATE....

On Sunday 24th May 2020 there will have been a church on Southgate Green for 405 years. We would have celebrated together in church. Instead make colourful stained glass biscuits. You could hang them up in the sunlight.... or just share eating them.

## You will need:

200g self-raising flour  
100g castor sugar  
100g margarine  
1 beaten egg  
A squeeze of lemon juice  
150g crushed boiled sweets  
(place in a bag, cover with a tea towel and bash with a rolling pin!)

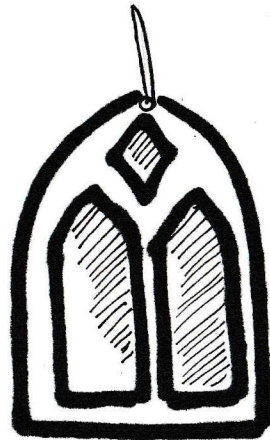
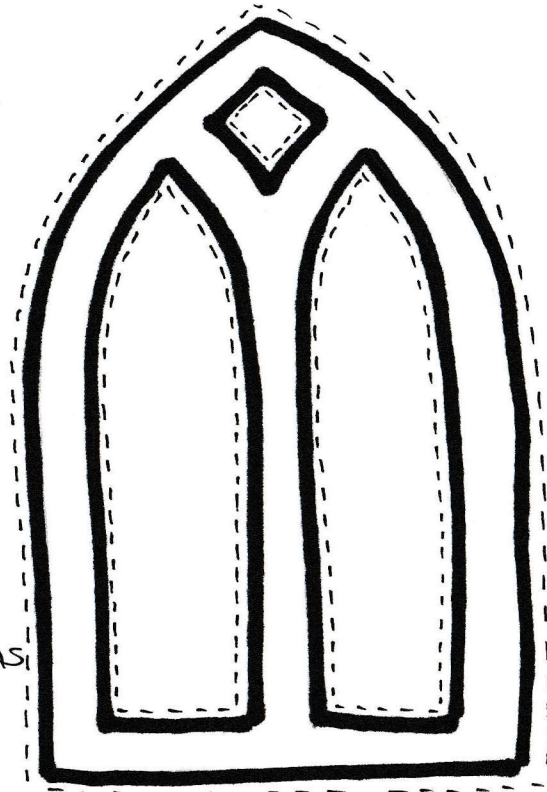
Baking tray  
oiled greaseproof paper  
Rolling pin

## Method:

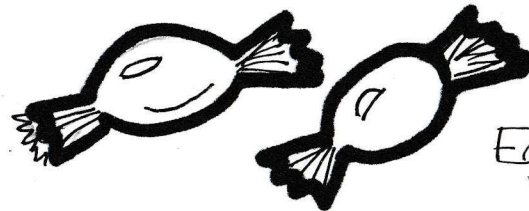
Mix together the flour and sugar. Rub in the margarine. Mix to a stiff dough with the egg and lemon juice. Knead well and then roll the dough out.

Cut into 15-20 window shapes using the template.  
Place the shapes on the greaseproof paper on a baking tray.  
Fill the centres with crushed sweets.

Bake for about 15 mins.  
Gas Mark 4 / 180°C.



Allow to cool completely before peeling off the paper.
