You could hang them up in the sunlight.... or just
share eating them.

You will need :




200g self-raising flour
100g castor sugar
100g margarine
1 beaten egg
A squeeze of lemon juice
150g crushed boiled sweets
(place in a bag, cover with a
tea towel and bash with
a rolling pin!)

Baking tray
oiled greaseproof paper
Rolling pin

Method :

Mix together the flour and sugar.
Rub in the margarine. Mix to
a stiff dough with the egg and
lemon juice. Knead well and
then roll the dough out.

Cut into 15-20
window shapes using
the template.
Place the shapes on
the greaseproof paper
on a baking tray.
Fill the centres with
crushed sweets.
Bake for about 15 mins
Gas Mark 4 / 180°C.



Allow to cool completely before
peeling off the paper.
