

A STAINED GLASS CHURCH WINDOW... 1/2

There has been a church on the green in Southgate since 24th May 1615 ... 405 years! You can still see the footprint of the original chapel next to our lovely church building.

The church today was built in Victorian times and has very beautiful stained glass with designs by the Pre-Raphaelite artists.


Make your own stained glass sun catcher:

- You need either black paper/card or colour your design edge black.
- Mark out your design and cut out the shapes.
- You will need coloured tissue paper or cellophane to fill in the gaps.
- Check your design and colours before gluing.
- Punch a hole, add a thread and hang up.
- You can also make them using tracing paper and felt tip pens

This template is very traditional but you can design your own shapes. See the next sheet for some more ideas.


Make them in all shapes and sizes!

- Please be careful with scissors and glue.




