


PETER THE FISHERMAN 1/2



- When Jesus called Peter to be his first disciple he was a fisherman.




Use this boat template to make a fishing boat collage or even a mobile.

• "I follow Jesus" Fish






- Cut a fish shape like this one on stiff coloured or patterned paper.
- Fold in half and make angled cuts.
- Fold back the V shapes.
- Write your promise and your name

- Sail your boat across the waves sharing Jesus' words.



Jesus said "Follow me"



1. Make a background picture of sky and sea.
2. Write a Bible verse on a wavy strip of paper.
3. Make a Sailing boat with a deep hull and cut 2 slits.
4. Assemble the picture, feed the strip through the slits. Staple the ends to the picture.

- Junk model a boat on wheels. What can you make a boat from? Small or big enough to sit in...
- 1. Cardboard boxes for the hull
- 2. Garden cones for axles
- 3. Paper for sails (or even fabric)
- 4. Cotton Reels, cardboard circles or (even real wheels from an old buggy if making a big boat)
- 5. Use plasticine, blu tack for small sails (A tall mast might need adult help to fix safely to the hull.)
- If there is more than one of you then maybe you can have a race.
- What will you name your boat?
- Design your own boat.
