It must have been amazing!

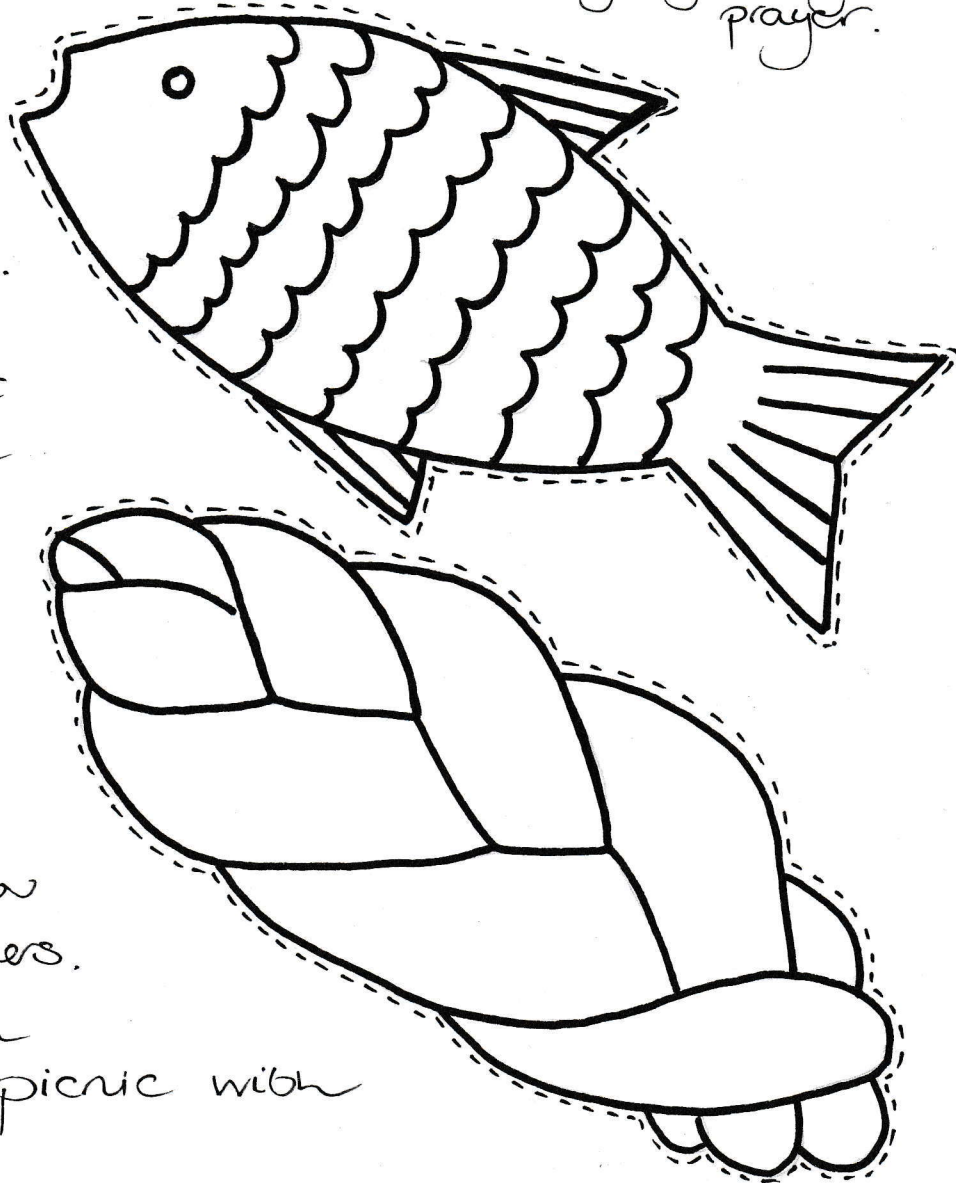
The young boy and Jesus showed the importance of giving and sharing what we have with others.

1. Cut out the lunch box template on thin card.
Decorate the box
2. Fold along the dotted lines and glue the long sides together
3. Fold tab 1 down, and tuck tabs 2 and 3 in the slot
Tuck tab 4 in the slot
4. Punch holes over the circles on each side and thread ribbon handles.
