



TAKE UP YOUR CROSS ... 1/2

In our Lent readings this week we are told that if we are followers of Jesus we must take up our cross and follow him. Jesus died on a cross on Good Friday. The cross has become the most recognised Christian symbol. Try making your own cross design or use one of the shapes here to make a stained glass hanging cross.

You will need coloured tissue paper or tracing paper to colour / glue stick / scissors / thread to hang your design
You could choose to colour the designs, bright glass colours with felt tip pens.

See page 2 for more designs that are window shaped.



- Cut round the templates.
- Colour or cut out inside the black lines (You might need help with this.)
- Use tissue shapes glued in or cut out tracing paper shapes glued then in and add felt tip colour.

- Punch a hole and thread a hanging.
- Put them up in a window to catch the light.
- Or stick on card and make bookmarks.
