

Your Church, Your Gift

Many people give regularly to Christ Church Southgate to support the mission and ministry of the parish. Gifts in wills are a natural part of that giving.

The PCC has written a Legacy Policy confirming that, however large or small, they will use your gift to make a real difference to the parish. As needs change over the years, the PCC encourages gifts to be left for the general purposes of the parish. The PCC will discuss the most appropriate use of donors' gifts in the light of their known areas of interest in the church and parish.

How to write a Will

We strongly advise you to consult a solicitor when writing or amending your will.

Suggested wording for your will

I give ______ % of my residuary estate [OR I give the sum of £ _____ (pounds sterling)] free of all taxes to the Parochial Church Council of the parish of Christ Church Southgate in the Diocese of London (Registered Charity No. 1131606) for its general purposes, and I declare that the receipt of the Vicar and Churchwardens shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors and trustees.

A gift in your will can be an expression of your gratitude and thanksgiving towards God, and can help keep Christ Church Southgate alive, and transform its future. No matter how large or small, every gift that is left to Christ Church Southgate can make a difference.
