10 am Sung Eucharist Our main Parish Eucharist with robed choir. Children's Corner. Refreshments served after the service.

6.30 pm Choral Evensong Traditional Evensong from the Book of Common Prayer, which includes full choral settings of the Responses, Canticles, Psalm and Anthem.

Weekday Services are normally held in the Lady Chapel. Entry is via the small north door with the ramp.

When You Visit

We welcome children to all of our services. There is an eco-friendly Children's Corner full of books, drawing materials and toys, which relate to the theme and readings of the service.

Nursing mothers are welcome to feed their babies wherever they feel most comfortable.

The toilet is located to the right of the high altar, through the choir vestry behind the organ. Follow the signs.

Large print orders of service and hymn books are available.

We have a hearing "T" loop installed and you can borrow a receiver with headphones if that would help you.

There is a permanent ramp for wheelchair access to the Church at the small door near the front of the Church,
